- 7. One of Supanich's affirmative defenses include his first amendment right of freedom of speech. This court can see by Plaintiffs exhibit 555 pages 1-3 that the written words are protected by the 1st amendment, do not threaten or are grounds for a tort claim.
- 8. Supanich objects and moves this court to compel plaintiff to provide defendants a legal address in which they can have access to due process by serving him when personal service is required. As it is now plaintiff changes motels every few days in many different states. For more than a year. He is recently divorced and has posted on his web pages he no longer a resident of Georgia.
- 9. Supanich objects and moves this court to strike this entire complaint for failing to state a claim in which relief can be attained.

Defendant Supanich reserves his right to file cross claims for Abuse of Process, Defamation, intentional infliction of emotional distress, fraud, invasion of privacy and interfering with business relations and any civil rights violations he may learn of.

- 10. Supanich objects to the time frame in which he has had to respond. The complaint is not a short statement of the facts or even a proper complaint. I am not an attorney and had no need to know the Missouri laws before now, since I am not a resident. For a non attorney that alone can take more than thirty days to learn. I have put in my best effort to comply even by, going without sleep for several days at a time, giving up jobs I should be doing and was served the day before my cancer surgery.
- 11. Supanich objects that plaintiff has brought this suit against him in bad faith, it is frivolous, without merit and Plaintiff comes with unclean hands. He has and continues to post defamatory statements about many people around the country, he stalks them, he gives out personal information including protected medical information on minors as well as adults.
